What's it all about?

Camp Brookwood is an Anglican Church camp located in the heart of New Brunswick's finest woodlands. It sits on 25 acres of beautiful land, where campers are encouraged to know God through many natural wonders experienced through the Camp.



The program includes swimming in the pool (*supervised by a qualified lifeguard*), recreation, hiking, handicrafts, Christian Education (*including Bible Study and worship*), games, special events, campfires, etc. While at camp, instruction is offered in swimming and water safety.

Campers live in four cabins which each hold seven people plus a responsible counsellor. There is no smoking on camp property. There is a Chaplain for each camp, who looks after spiritual instruction, arranges worship and generally oversees the spiritual life of the Camp.
