HAROLD PERCY
ON EVANGELISM

Canon Harold Percy has been the Incumbent of the Anglican parish of Trinity, Streetsville in Mississauga, Ontario since 1987. In 1991 he became the founding Director of The Wycliffe College Institute of Evangelism in the Toronto School of Theology. He remained Director of the Institute until May, 1998 when he stepped down in order to devote more time to his parish ministry. He continues with the Institute as Consultant on Leadership and Congregational Development. Harold is the author of "Following Jesus: First Steps on the Way:", and "Good News People: An Introduction to Evangelism For Tongue-Tied Christians", Harold travels widely throughout North America, speaking at conferences and leading workshops in the areas of congregational development, evangelism, and church growth.



RUTH CODE
ON DEALING
WITH LOSS
AND CHANGE

Ruth Code began speaking to woman's groups throughout Ontario for Stonecroft Ministries in the 1980's. After the death of her husband Willie, she began speaking fulltime. She became involved with Women Alive where she designed The Vibrant Woman series. In 2002 Ruth married Charlie Wight.

One year later, Charlie was diagnosed with cancer, and for the next eleven months Ruth became his caregiver and encourager. Charlie died in July 2004 and Ruth again became a widow. She married Mel Code, also a widower, in December of 2008. Ruth currently studies part-time at Regent College and continues to speak on a variety of topics. She will be addressing how to help individuals as well as church communities moves through times of grief and change.



MARION TAYLOR
PREACHING ON THE
OLD TESTAMENT

Marion Taylor was raised in Toronto and returned there in 1986 to teach Old Testament at Wycliffe College following graduate studies at Yale University. Her doctoral thesis on the history of Old Testament studies at Princeton Seminary from 1820-1929 was supervised by Brevard Childs. Her interests in the history of the interpretation of the Bible continue, centering more recently on women interpreters of the Bible. She is currently preparing a biographical dictionary of women interpreters of Scripture and preparing anthologies of nineteenth-century women's writings on the women in the gospels and the women in Exodus to Kings. Marion will be speaking on Preaching and interpreting the Old Testament.
