Interpreting the Scriptures in Post-modern Times: The Ethical Challenge

How does post modernity, including its secularization and pluralism, deeply affect the interpretation of the Bible or the proclamation of the Word of God?

We will review and assess various responses to post modernity:

- Fundamentalism
- Conservatism/Orthodoxy
- Liberal and Radical Approaches.

We will explore a hermeneutical approach with a key towards becoming ethically responsible interpreters of the Bible and of the Word of God.

Presenter & Facilitator

The Rev. Dr. Gerald Caron

A Roman Catholic priest and a member of the Missionaries of Africa, after his ordination, he pursued advanced theological and biblical studies in Rome and in Jerusalem. In 1971 he left Uganda after 11 years there, 9 of which were teaching biblical studies at Ggaba National Seminary. He returned to Canada and studied in Ottawa receiving both his DTh and PhD in biblical studies. In 1988 he accepted a position at AST as professor of Scripture Studies. He retired in 2005.

He continues to teach an occasional course at AST; however, most of his time is now spent writing on issues of interest. He has published two books in French and one in English: *Qui sont les Juifs de l'évangile de Jean, L'antisémitisme chrétien. Un défi pour les Églises*, and *A Postmodern Mark in the Lectionary: Ecumenical Study-guides on the Sunday Gospel Readings*. He also has written many articles and spoken at many conferences and workshops. As his most recent work illustrates, his main interest is biblical hermeneutics in post-modern times.
