Although breakfast is served from 7:30 – 8:30 a.m., we suggest that you plan to finish by 8:15 a.m. to allow yourself a little transportation time to the Aitken Center, as we begin our synod session with worship promptly at 8:30 a.m.

This afternoon we will be taking a field trip to Camp Medley. Camp Medley is still very much a construction site and I would ask you to watch your step and wear appropriate footwear. We will be boarding busses for Camp Medley directly from the floor of the Aitken Center via the center exit, next to the Soccer field.

Parking spaces have been reserved for those in wheelchairs or with limited mobility beside the Soccer field. The Wheelchair/Limited Mobility access is through the door beside the soccer field and up the ramp to the floor of the Aitken Center.

There are four sets of washrooms on the Upper Level of the Aitken Center as well as a washroom on the lower level, to the left of the access door as you come in beside the soccer field, for those in wheelchairs or with limited mobility. Please refer to the Aitken Center layout in your registration packs.

There will be a canteen operating through out Synod on the upper level just to the left of the stairs. It will provide coffee and tea to synod delegates for 50 cents per cup as well as lots of other goodies.

Water is available on the floor of Synod from two water coolers located on either side of Synod.

Lunch will be provided at the Aitken Center today and supper will be provided at Camp Medley this afternoon.
